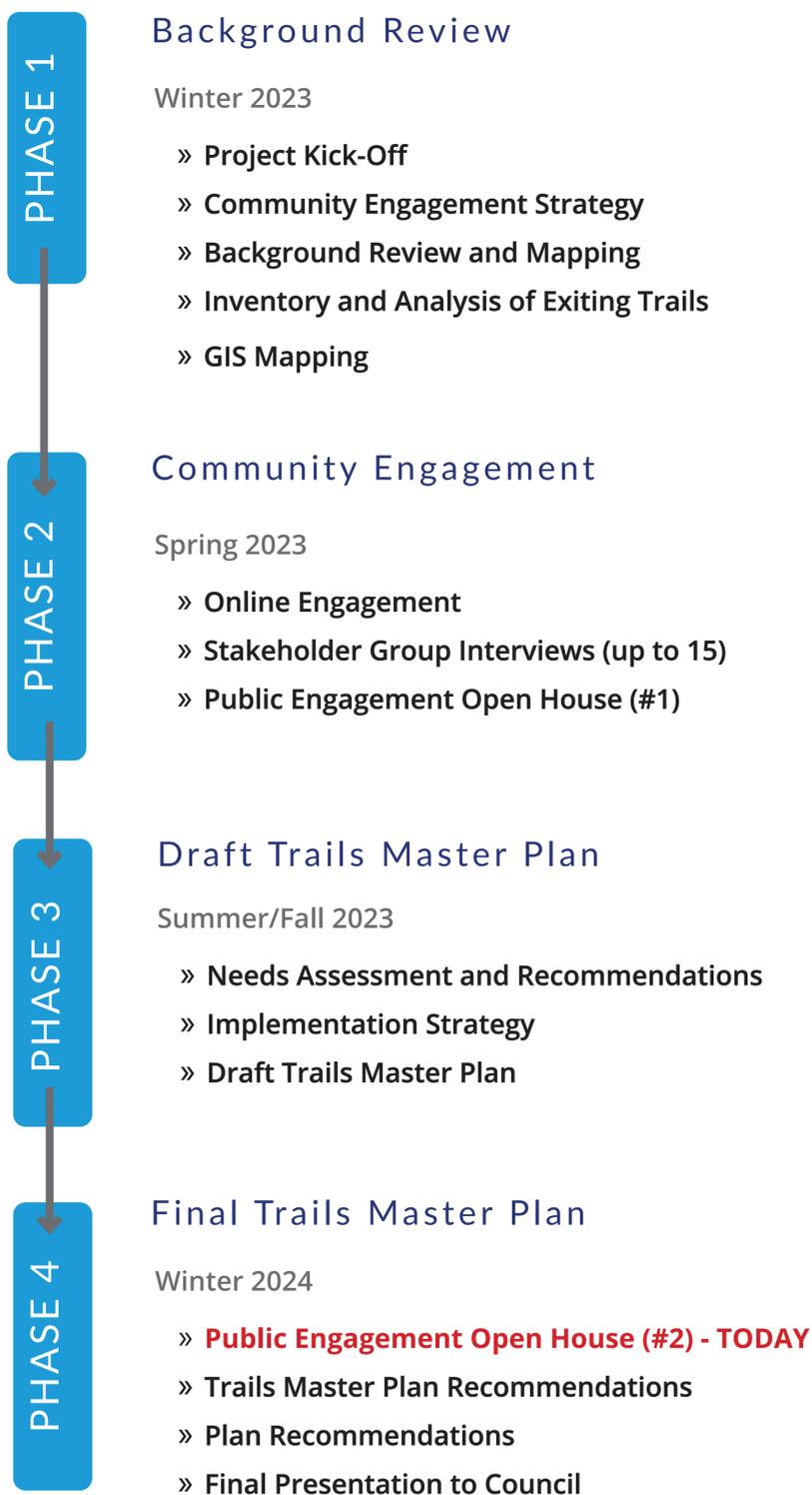


## PROJECT OVERVIEW

A3.2	GIS Specialist	Hire a GIS Specialist to manage Township map data including trails	
A4	Online Trails Portal	Create an online trails portal to share information and market trails in Springwater	
A5	Invasive Plant Species Management	Install boot brushes and invasive species signage. Partner with SSEA to educate users	
A6	Poison Ivy Educational Signage	Provide poison ivy educational signage at trailheads of trail segments where the plant is well established, and/or directly alongside a trail beside a poison ivy patch	
A7	Transportation Master Plan Coordination	Ensure integration of transportation master plan with trails developments	
A8	Land transfer to the Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority	Transfer ownership of unopened road allowances located within the Minesing Wetlands to the NVCA	
A9	Trails Communication Strategy	Trails Coordinator to create a Trails Communication Strategy, In order to better communicate information about trails in Springwater	
A10	E-Bike Policy	Establish an e-bike policy, to provide clear direction on e-bike use on municipal trails	
A11	Trail Signage Strategy	Work with a design consultant to develop a Trail Signage strategy	
A12	Comprehensive Land Access Strategy	Township to adopt a comprehensive land access strategy to ensure the tools are in place to expand trails when opportunities arise

A14	Hydro Corridors	Investigate the feasibility of using hydro corridors for trails in Springwater. Reach out to local hydro one representative to determine which, if any hydro corridors are compatible with official trails use

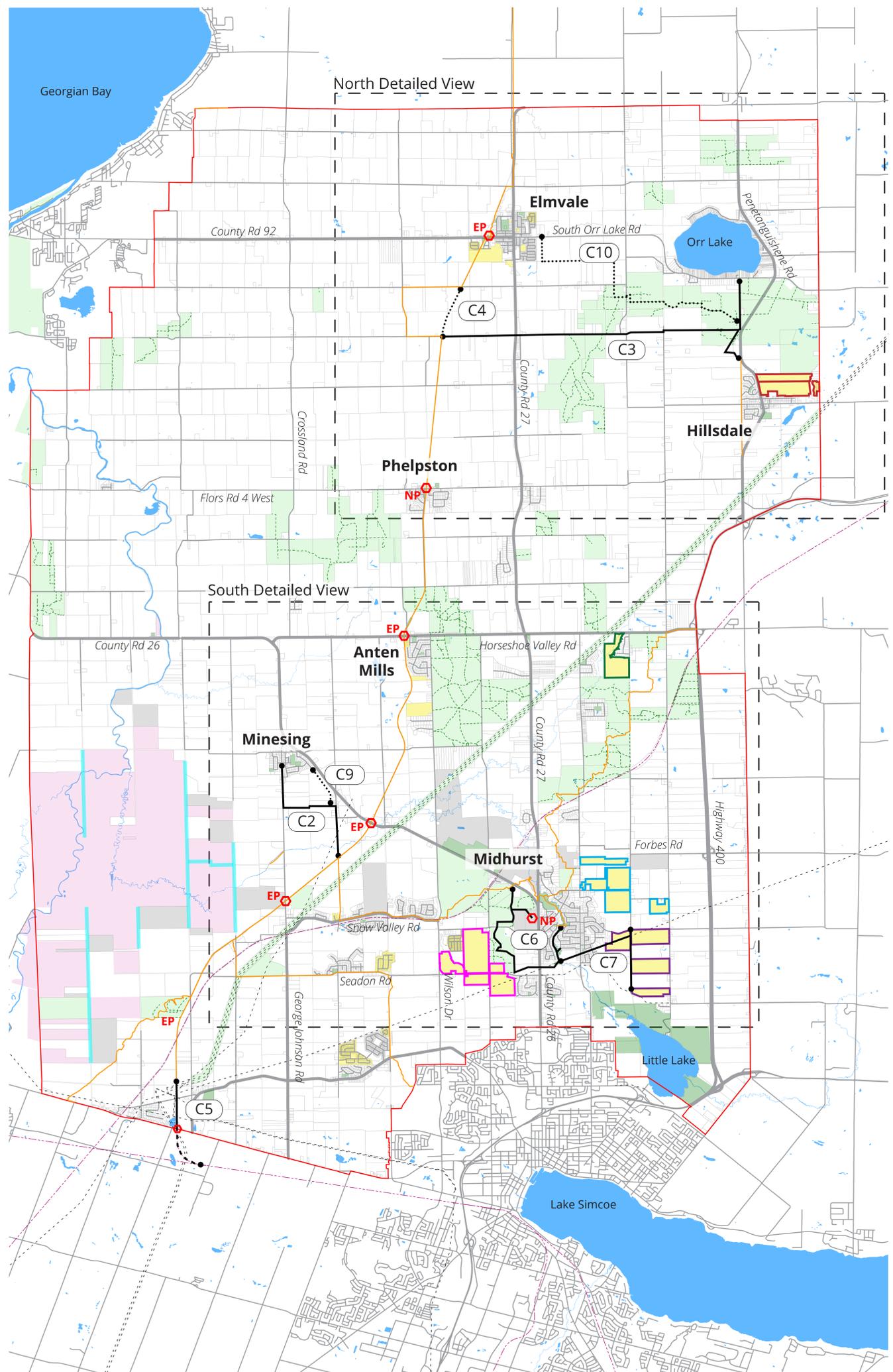
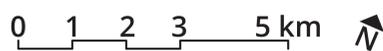

T1	Trails Workshops	Host a trial building and maintenance workshops for Township Staff and the proposed Trail Committee	
T2	Trails Maintenance and Development Best Practices	Prepare a summary document of best practices for designing and developing trails	
T3	Improve Trail Crossings	Work with a traffic engineer to design safe and accessible trail crossings at priority locations along the North Simcoe Rail Trail and Nine Mile Portage Trail	
T4	Interpretive Signage	Replace and update existing interpretive signage and provide new signage in select locations	
T5	Trailheads	Adapt and implement trailhead hierarchy at designated location. Major trailsheads to include parking, signage, seating, etc. Minor trailsheads to only include signage and mapping	
T6	Trails Classification Hierarchy	Will continue to implement trail hierarchy outlined in 2008 plan	
T7	9 Mile Portage - Seadon Road Improvements	Improve the section of 9 Mile Portage that goes along Seadon Road. Widened the shoulder and update existing signage with new larger signs

O2	Trails Safety and Enforcement Education	Proposed Trails Committee to create a strategy to communicate rules, etiquette and protocol for ORVs	
O3	Continue and Expand Education Events	Continue to host and expand ORV education days	
O4	Off Road Vehicle Recreation Management Campaign	Increase enforcement of ORV laws in Springwater using hired services of paid duty OPP	
O5	Gate Design	Fix issues with existing gates, create a better design for future gates	
O6	ORVs on Municipal Roads	Re-evaluate which roads permit ORV use. Focus on maintaining key connections to ORV permitted County forest tracts

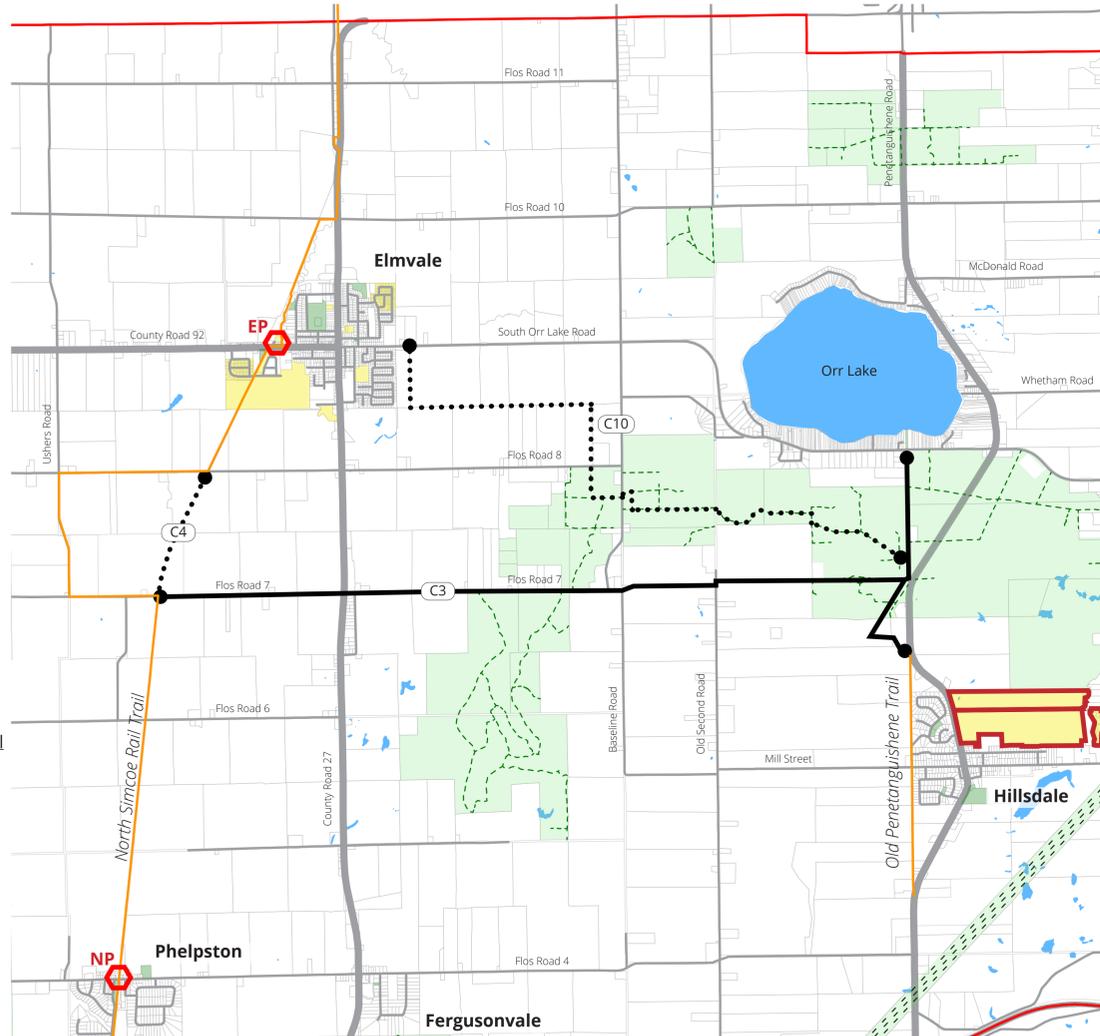


FIGURE 2: NORTH DETAILED VIEW

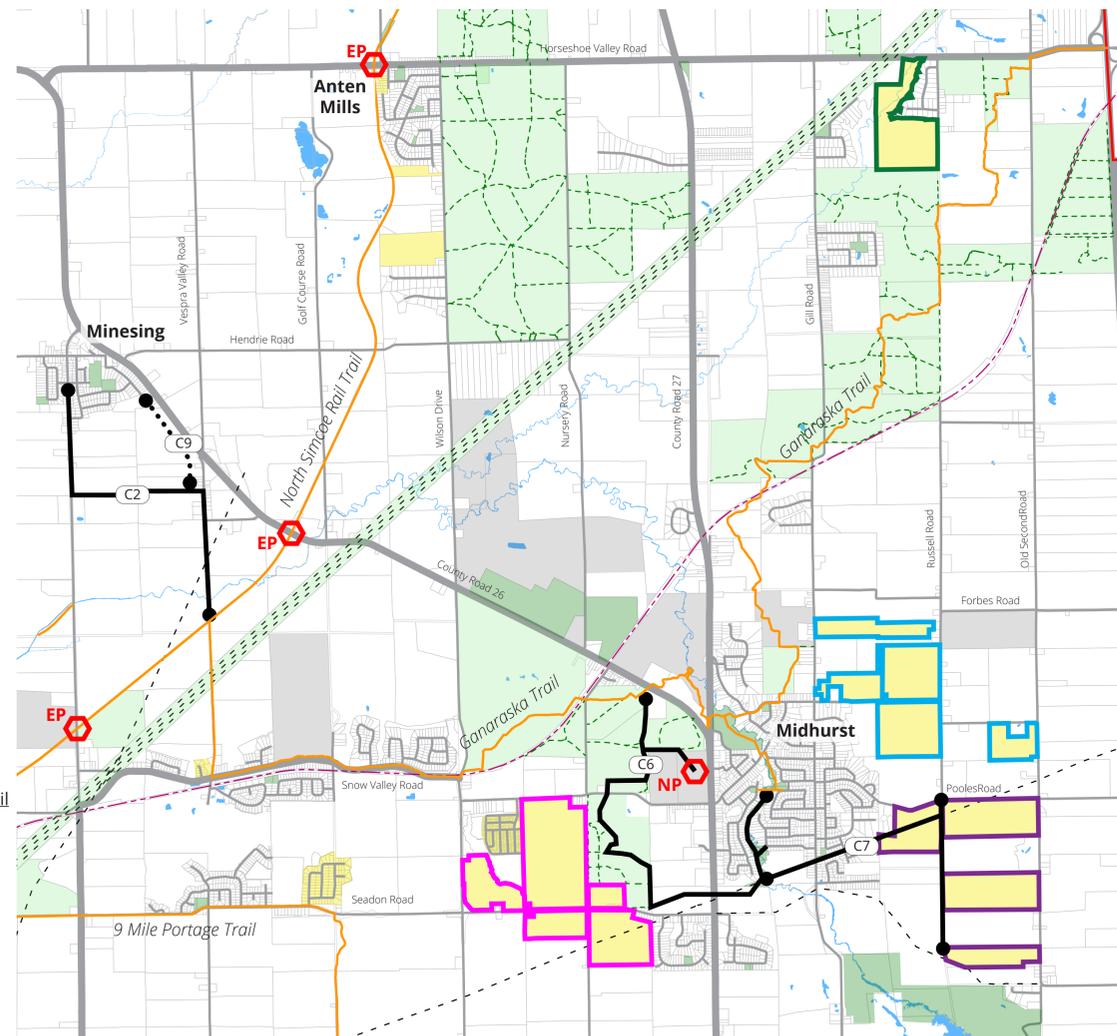


FIGURE 3: SOUTH DETAILED VIEW

## TRAIL CONNECTIONS

#	RECOMMENDATION	DESCRIPTION	PLACE DOTS ON YOUR FAVOURITE RECOMMENDATIONS HERE:
C1	New Development Trails	Work with developers to ensure the outlined trails are considered in future residential developments (see development clusters)	
C2	Minesing Connection	Connect the community of Minesing to the NSRT with an on-road route (See Figure 1&3)	
C3	Trail Connection to Hillsdale	Connect Hillsdale to Elmvale and the NSRT using County Forests, existing trails and on road routes. Signage, and eventually a widened/paved shoulder should be considered for Flos Road 7 (See Figure 1&2)	
C4	North Simcoe Rail Trail Between the 7th and 8th Concession	Secure off road route for on road section of North Simcoe Rail Trail between Flos Road 7 and Flos Road 8 (See Figure 1&2)	
C5	North Simcoe Rail Trail Extension to Essa Township	Work with the township of Essa and Simcoe County to extend the North Simcoe Rail trail to connect to future Barrie-Collingwood Rail Trail (See Figure 1)	
C6	Midhurst Trail Loop	Work towards completing the southern gap of the Midhurst trail loop through use of suitable landscape access strategies (See Figure 1&3)	
C7	Midhurst East-West Connection	Create linkage to further subdivisions using the existing hydro corridor and road allowance (See Figure 1&3)	
C8	Develop Trails in Conjunction with the Proposed Community Hub Project	Ensure trails are a main consideration in the community hub project. At minimum, provide a 2 km paved accessible multi-use trail as part of this development	
C9	Off Road Minesing Connection	When possible work towards creating a fully off-road connection from the North Simcoe Rail Trail to Minesing (See Figure 1&3)	
C10	Off Road Hillsdale Connection	When possible work towards creating a fully off-road connection from Elmvale and the North Simcoe Rail Trail to Hillsdale (See Figure 1&2)
